YOU MUST NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY SYMPTOMS

9:00 arrival and set up

EVERYONE MUST WEAR FACE COVERINGS AND SANITISE THEIR HANDS BEFORE ENTERING THE ARENA TO HELP SET UP THE EQUIPMENT

Please park in the visitor car park behind the wooden panel fencing.

Park carefully and considerately to others as there will be no parking attendants, those parking inconsiderately will be asked to move their car to the furthest point of the car park for being inconsiderate to others

Judging will start once the course has been built and walked

A fun show aimed at beginners to G3 – higher grades can enter for clear round only





NFC runners are requested to run at the end of the class to give the judge a chance of a break – you will have 1 minute in the ring and MUST leave when told your time is up

Limited number of entries

£15 for 3 runs

Classes
Agility (Aframe, dog walk and 6 weaves)
Jumping (6 weaves)
Steeplechase (jumps and tunnels only)

No running orders will be published run at your height. If you have more than one dog to run in a height ensure that you're ready for a quick turn around as there are only a limited number of entries.

VENUE

Woodside Equestrian Centre, Forest Road, Colgate, Horsham, RH12 4TF

Coming from Horsham (A24/A264) as you travel along Forest Road you will come to a left hand bend up a small hill the venue is on your right.

Coming from Pease Pottage/Colgate (A264/A23/M23) as you travel along Forest Road you will travel past a conference centre and a southern water area. After the left hand bend the venue is a little further along on your left

THIS IS A WORKING LIVERY YARD, YOU MUST NOT ACCESS THE YARD OR ANY WHERE ELSE THAT IS SIGNPOSTED FOR NO ENTRY. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON THE LEAD UNLESS THEY ARE COMPETING IN THE RING.

During government guidelines in relation to Covid-19 I will make every effort to ensure that everything I do is in conjunction with these guidelines. Therefore, I expect anyone attending any of my events to ensure they're aware of the latest information via the gov.co.uk website and that should they be suffering any symptoms, or have known to be around anyone with the symptoms to not attend any events.

Rules & Regulations

- In the case of unavoidable cancellation refunds will follow once costs have been recovered
- Only dogs in the ring are to be off their lead
- Open to dogs over 15 months
- No toys are allowed in the ring unless you wish to run NFC
- No food in the ring
- Heights available are small, medium, intermediate and large these shows are for fun
 and confidence building so if you would like to run your dog at one height lower for
 competition (excluding small) then you may. You may jump lower if you wish but this
 will be classed as an NFC run and for a clear round only.
- No squeaky toys around the ring
- No bitches in season





- No harsh handling, you will be asked to leave the show
- You must clear up after dogs and take waste home as there are no waste facilities at this venue
- Timing will be manual.
- No running orders you will need to run at your entered height, jumps will not be changed once they have moved to the next height

EMERGENCY VETS

Seers Croft - Tower Rd, Faygate, Horsham RH12 4SD

Turn right out of the venue and continue down the road to Colgate. When you enter Colgate and see The Dragon pub on your right then Tower Road is opposite this on your left. Turn left down Tower Road and continue down this road until you arrive at Seers Croft on your left.

HOW THE SHOW WILL WORK

Everyone is to maintain social distancing unless for a specific reason such as equipment moving. Should anyone need to be in proximity of another then PPE/hand sanitiser must be used.





There will be a ONE-WAY system in place – KEEP LEFT and the Gallery will be OUT OF BOUNDS

There will only be a limited amount of space available in the arena for those helping or wishing to stay inside, these will be prioritised for those running multiple dogs, helping and any remaining will be pre-book only and on a first come first served basis. If you do not book a space, you can only enter the arena when walking a course or running your dog.

There will be four height **GROUPS**

- A. Small
- B. Medium
- C. Intermediate
- D. Large

Essentially the show will work around a cycle Group A will walk the course then get their dogs

Group B will walk the course and then leave the arena

Group A will run the course then leave the arena as soon as they finish

As Group A leave the arena and Group C can walk the course and the leave the arena and Group B can get their dogs ready to run

Group B will run the course then leave the arena as soon as they finish

As Group B leave Group D can walk the course and leave the arena and Group C can get their dogs ready to run

Group C will run the course then leave the arena as soon as they finish

Group D can get their dogs ready to run, run the course then leave the arena as soon as they finish

- 1. Walk Course face coverings should be worn
- 2. Prepare your dog and yourself
- 3. Queue & run dog (wear face covering while queuing)
- 4. Leave arena for rest

Time in the arena should be restricted as much as possible.

Those staying within the arena for any length of time must wear a face covering, this includes helping to set up equipment, pack it down, walking the course, queuing. You will be asked to put, leave or throw your lead to the exit point as we do not want to handle everyone's items.

The main thing for running events like these is that EVERYONE sticks to government guidelines, anyone found to be mingling will be asked to leave and will not be permitted to return to any future events and will forfeit their entry fees.

We are all in this together, lets be safe and sensible so these events can continue in the future
